QUINCY, Ill. (AP) — The FBI has no plans to question the brother of James Earl Ray any further about the shooting of civil rights leader Vernon Jordan, a spokesman for the agency said Thursday.

FBI agent Wayne G. Davis said that "at this juncture" there will be no further inter-

views with John Larry Ray, brother of James Earl Ray, who pleaded guilty to assassinating civil rights leader Martin Luther King Jr.

"In the absence of any other information, we don't anticipate talking to him again," Davis said. "He wasn't considered a suspect when we taked with him"
