## **Police Seek Brother**

(UPI) — A warrant was issued yesterday for the arrest of John Larry Ray, the brother of James Earl Ray, the convicted assas-sin of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., in the \$15,000 armed robbery of the Farmers Bank of Liberty. The bank was robbed May 30. A spokesman for the Illinois Depart-ment of Law Enforcement said state and Adams County officials believed they had "conclusive evidence" that Ray, 47, was involved in the robbery.
