

## Police Seek Brother Of James Earl Ray

QUINCY, Ill. (UPI) — A warrant was issued yesterday for the arrest of John Larry Ray, the brother of James Earl Ray, the convicted assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., in the \$15,000 armed robbery of the Farmers Bank of Liberty.

The bank was robbed May 30. A spokesman for the Illinois Department of Law Enforcement said state and Adams County officials believed they had "conclusive evidence" that Ray, 47, was involved in the robbery. Bond on the warrant was set at \$200,000 for Ray, who has a previous bank robbery conviction, authorities said.
