 AND LIVED WITH HER BETWEEN IMPRISONMENTS UNTIL HER DEATH. STATES
 RAY BROTHERS IN SL AREA INTERMITTENTLY FIFTY EIGHT AND FIFTY NINE.
 DENIED CONTACT BY SUBJECT SINCE PRISON ESCAPE OR KNOWLEDGE OF PRE-
 SENT WHEREABOUTS. WILL BE RE-INTERVIEWED FOLLOWING SL VISIT OF JERRY
 RAY. COMPARISON OF INFO TO BE OBTAINED AT THAT TIME WITH INFO
 CHICAGO WILL OBTAIN FROM JERRY MAY SERVE AS CROSS CHECK OF DEGREE OF
 COOPERATION OF BOTH, AS THERE IS GOOD PROBABILITY THEY MAY MEET DUR-
