Dear John,

Separately I have sent you all four of my published books.

That's a lot of words and a lot of time you may not have.

What is most appropriate to an understanding of what we discussed is the chapter "The Doctors and the Autopsy" of WHITEWASH. If you can take the time to read the chapter immediately preceding, "The Number of Shots", I think it will help.

On the notes of the doctors, page 183. On who swore the bullet hit in the back, not the neck, and were ignored - or never witnesses - page 185. The FBI report is in my unpublished POST MORTEM. You can have a copy if you want.

On page 195 you will find facsimile excerpts from the FBI "Summary Report" showing that even Hoover, on December 9, 1963, told the President and the Commission that each of the men were hit by separate bullets each of which hit no one else.

There is more, if you have the time, in WHITEWASH II, beginning on page 93. Then, again, on page 113. Specific reference to the FBI agents is on pp. 123 ff. This includes what they saw, heard and did.

My apologies for having to publish unedited first drafts, and my thanks to you both. It is encouraging to know that there is even the possibility that a major voice may interest itself in what I regard as the issue that may control the future of freedom.
