On April 22, 1965, Mr. Marion Johnson of your staff advised Special Agent John C. Stokes of this Bureau that Warren Commission Document Number 1380 had been located. Mr. Johnson requested an expression of our views as to whether or not Document 1380 should be placed in the public domain.

Applying guideline number two approved by the Honorable McGeorge Bundy, Special Assistant to the President, on April 19, 1965, it is our view that Document 1380 should now be included in our List C; namely, a document which should not at this time be placed in the public domain.
