JACK L. RUBY, AKA; LLE HARVLY OSWALD, AKA-Victin; CR OO:DL

On 7/27/64, the writer obtained from Lva Grant, sister of Ruby, two boxes of papers which had not theretofore been in our possession. One box was found by me to consist primarily of an accumulation of copies of invoices for purchases of supplies and equipment for operation of the Carousel Club and its predecessor. the Sovereign Club. The other box had similar papers relative to the Vegas Club, which Eva Grant operated for Ruby. There appeared to be no information having any possible relevance to the assassination of President Kennedy, the killing of Oswald, or any other facet of the investigation.

Prior to the return of the papers to Ers. Grant, they were photographed and the Bureau developed the films, retaining two copies and returning one copy to Dallas. Thereafter, on 8/11/64. I prepared a LHM for the Bureau, by which Bureau transmitted to the President's Commission, one set of the photographs.

Pertinent serials in the above connection are 44-1629-5884and 5995. We have been retaining out copy of the photographs as Bulky Exhibit 1B2.

I have on this date reexamined the papers in question and again consider they positively have no bearing on the investigation or or future possibilities of pertinent investigation. Accordingly, is myA recommendation, in the interests of space, that 44-1639-1 B 2 BL DESTROYED.
