Asserting "there is no such thing as an isolationist in this country," Senator Reynolds (Democrat) of North Carolina called yesterday for "a revival of nationalism."

"We are not isolationists," he declared. "There is no such thing in this country. An isolationist would have to favor abandonment of the Monroe Doctrine and of commercial relations among nations.

"We do favor considering America first, instead of giving so much time to problems of other parts of the world."
