MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING

On 4/6/66, Mr. WARREN A. REYNOLDS, who testified before the President's Commission on the assassination, telephonically advised he had consented to an interview which was filmed, with one ROBERT BLAKE, which interview was doncuted on 3/30/66. Mr. REYNOLDS stated since his interview he has learned that ROBERT BLAKE was actually MARK LANE. He requested advice as to what action he should take. He was advised that no advice could be given.
