phierence this was the
first time in the organizaion's 51-year history that
thad opposed a candidate
dr public office.
"The ACLU prizes its
tradition of political nonpartisanship," Ennis said.
"We have taken an extraordinary step because
of extraordinary circumitances."
Rehnquist's nomination
will be debated in the
Senate this week.
