On 11/26/63, BARNEY H. TIMMINS, JR., AUSA,
telephonically advised that he had been in receipt of
a telephone call from an [REDACTED]
who maintains offices at [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] had called him with the
following information:

A friend and client of [REDACTED] after the
death of President KENNEDY went to the Irving area and
wandered around the river bottom and river banks near
OSWALD's reported residence thinking that OSWALD may
have indulged in some target practice prior to the
shooting. Apparently this friend found some tin cans
full of holes which appeared to be bullet holes and also
discovered a tree which appeared to have been climbed by
someone and he speculated that shots may have been fired
from this tree. [REDACTED] has the tin cans in his office
at the present time and can be contacted any time after
3:00 p.m. this date.

TIMMINS commented that [REDACTED] desired that
his identity be kept confidential since there a
possibility that he would be representing JACK RUBY
in the forthcoming murder trial. TIMMINS commented that
there were possibly a lot of people who held target
practice at the river bottom in Irving but he felt
obligated to pass this information on to the Bureau.
