Thank you very much for the two copies of L'Europeo of September 15 and the fine set of pictures. Mr. Orlando certainly gave me generous attention, which I do appreciate.

I believe there was also mention of my book or me in the issue current on August 29. If this is so and it is not too much trouble, I would very much appreciate a copy of that.

Although I have completed the rough draft of the sequel of which I told Mr. Orlando, my interest in the subject is by no means at an end. In the search for additional information, I would like to know the address in Italy of the newspaper Paese Sera, if you know it. Thank you very much.

When you next see Mr. Orlando, there are two things (other than my gratitude) that might interest him: information I located after we talked convinces me even more of the source of the whitewash and of the unusual involvements, and the sale of my book is now past 16,000 and by this time next week the 'in print" figure will exceed 21,000 (closer to 22,000). And there is possibly a third item: the long-overdue special issue of Remperts is now due October 20. It has other information, but emphasizes the strange deaths that so upset the actuarial tables in Dallas. Should Mr. Orlando have an interest in this aspect, I highly recommend Mr. Penn Jones, the courageous editor of the weekly Midlothian (Tex.) Mirror as his best source. Mr. Jones has written and published a book, Forgive Type of the much of this information.
