

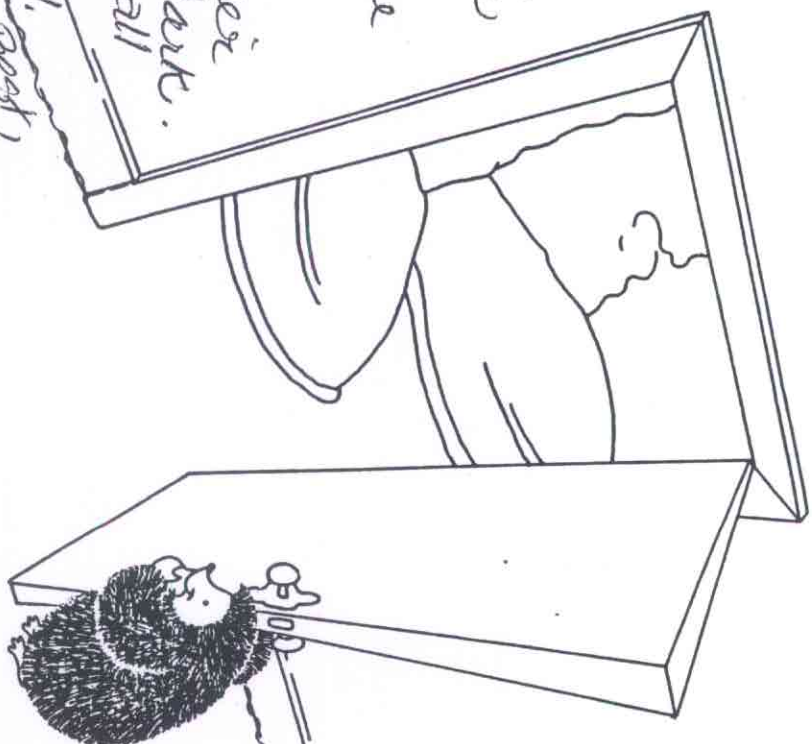

I won't mail this until next week, when I've been promised the bill for the copying. The young woman who operates the place while her husband sells and services copiers has not had time to go to the post office for stamps! (Maybe they'll hear of a machine yet.)

On getting your cute card and the page of de Mòs phone numbers I remembered the 1963 Dallas phone book. There is no listing of the CIA under that name or under US government.

J. Walton <sup>Moore</sup> ~~Moore~~ is listed, home at 5145 Rextant Lane,,361-0749, office, Reliance Life Bldg., 747-5647. There is no listing for this building or for Reliance Life. There is one for the Reliance Life Barber Shop, at 505 N. Irvay. The listing for the FBI does not resemble any of these or the typed numbers on the sheet you sent.

While I have no knowledge I am reasonably certain that George knew very well that Moore was CIA domestic contact service and not FBI.

Have you any idea when he typed these listings? Or where he then lived?

Something comes to mind vaguely. When George left on his walking tour of Mexico he started from the home of a friend at Eagle Pass, TX. Some year later that friend figured in the news and I think suggesting some kind of spooking and an airplane. With the name I could probably get some clipping if I remember correctly. Unless they are in the copies you now have.

I had no interest in J. Walton Moore hence have no file on him.
