LONDON, June 20 (AP)—A leftist Laborite lawmaker accused the government today of failing to investigate allegations that the J. Walter Thompson advertising agency in London was being used as a cover for spying by the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency.

The lawmaker, Tom Litterick, asked Hom Secretary Roy Jenkins in the House of Commons about he reports.

Jenkins replied he would consider any information that Litterick himself had to offer.

Denis Lanigan, chairman of J. Walter Thompson in London, said: "I can say quite categorically that our company has no connection with the CIA and never has had."
