**U.S. Ad Agency,
CIA Tie Alleged**

LONDON, June 20 (AP)—
A leftist Laborite lawmaker
accused the government to-
day of failing to investigate
allegations that the J. Wal-
ter Thompson advertising
agency in London was being
used as a cover for spying
by the U.S. Central Intelli-
gence Agency.

The company, a subsidiary
of the American corpora-
tion, denied the claims made
in several press reports.

The lawmaker, Tom Lit-
terick, asked Hom Secretary
Roy Jenkins in the House of
Commons about the reports.
Jenkins replied he would
consider any information
that Litterick himself had to
offer.

Denis Lanigan, chairman
of J. Walter Thompson in
London, said: "I can say
quite categorically that our
company has no connection
with the CIA and never has
had."
