Dear Harold (cc Dick),

I picked up your latest mailing at home yesterday, and have glanced over the letters. I'll go over them again and answer as I go along.

Nichols sent me a copy of the gov'T's response to his suit, a request for dismissal on the grounds that the court has no jurisdiction. It's about 50 pages long, with much appended stuff, including several affidavits from Rhoads, etc. If you don't get a copy, tell me and I'll have mine Xeroxed. I really don't know what to make of it. Nichols says "We intend to go forward with this as early as possible."
