Dear Harold,

I make hasty response to a mailing of yours received last week.

I still am not clear on your "lady" re the Harper slides, etc. I remember no report by a woman correspondent in your files. At any rate, I don't see how she can help me get the Harper pix. You cited a ruling that if part of the file is revealed, all must be, thus now that I have part of CD 1269, I am entitled to the rest. I'd like to take this up with A.

The black Star pix, which I copied at your place once, do show curtain rods being hammered in with curtains on them. Those were taken morning 11/23. UPI pix which I saw were taken evening 11/22 and seem to show curtains also. When I get the money, I'll order a copy.
