Dear Harold,

I'm including this last minute brief note.

First, I forget to mention that if you do come to Phila, please know that you are more than welcome to stay here for whatever time you may need. If you come up to see Fillinger, then feel free to stop in to freshen up if you have to or, if there is a need, to stay over.

Second concerns some questions which come to mind as I ponder possibilities of Oswald's guilt. Consider this: Is there any way LHO could have gotten the MC into the TSBD other than carrying it to work that morning. For instance, how do we know that it was not at his apartment and he took it to the TSBD on another day prior to that. Frazier only drove him on the weekends (Fri and Monday) so he couldn't know if LHO carried something the other days. (I assume that Oswald took a bus to work on other days.) Do you know of anything to vitiate this or support it? True, there is no evidence the rifle was even in his possession at the time.

I mention these things about LHO as they come to mind. They are not really central in themselves but I think they deserve thought since we can never know all the alternatives and it is best to consider as many as possible.
