Dear Harold,

I had an interesting experience 2 days ago which I'll relate to you.

Someone had told me that a "Free People's" store on campus was selling "the Kennedy assassination film." I went to the store and found that it had a little "assassination corner," which included an old copy of WWII (private ed) and O in NO, 2 copies of Farewell America, and a copy of Rush to Judgement. Also, there were a stack of 8mm reels in white boxes, each holding a single black and white copy of the Zapruder film, made doubtlessly from Newcomb's copy, available for \$1.50 a reel. I bought a copy and asked a young girl behind the counter where the store got these films. She said that Vince Salandria had provided a color copy which they had dubbed by a firm in New Jersey. She named the firm, but I forget it.
