Dear Howard,

Your letter of December 30 asks permission to cite the listed passages of my printed work. I had given you this permission verbally and I herein confirm it.

It may be remotely possible that in editing there may be a desire to quote other of this work. On the chance, remote as it may be, to save your time and any possible publisher concern, let me also repeat in writing what I told you: feel free to quote whatever you want without asking.

Your publisher's position is a proper one. In my long experience it is also unique. You are aware of extensive use of my work. I can't recall a case in which my permission was sought and there certainly is no case in which any publisher insisted on it.

You would seem to have an ethical publisher.
