I checked the NYT index for Morton Jackson and turned up nothing. I also checkedmy files and there is no story in them about or mentioning him in July-Aug '72. It is possible that I didn't clip it, or didn't get the paper that day, but both would be unusual. I did get and clip the 8/2/72 NYT and it wasn't in that.

Under separate cover I have mailed your CIA files, plus some recent Colson and CIA clips, as well as a file that I had previously borrowed, marked "David Wrone". In the latter file I think (and hope!) you will find a money order which I had purchased for you and Lil as a toekn of my appreciation. I cannot find it now, and that is the last place I remember it being. However, I sealed the package a}ready and have not filled out the order. So, when you get it, make it out to yourself and date it, please.

The week since I've returned has been unusually hectic and loaded with a broad spectrum of emotional happenings which have kept me from writing. Things are fine right now, but, as always, exciting.

This is a very quick note, but I'm in a terrific hurry. I'll have more to write later, but of no immediate importance.
