Dear Miss Smith:

The July 12, 1977 issue of "Midnight/Globe" reported that Frank Sturgis is in possession of an FBI document that allegedly links Lee Harvey Oswald to Fidel Castro and perhaps to the Kennedy assassination. I would like to know if this document is in the files of the Warren Commission. If so, I would like a copy of it and any other related records.

This FBI document is numbered MM105-8342 and is dated March 24, 1964. The article quoted from the document as follows:

"Mr. _____ believe that Oswald had travelled from Mexico to Oriente Province, Cuba, prior to November, 1963, then returning to the United States.

"Reportedly Oswald used an airstrip located on the estate of former Mexican President Lazaro Cardenas in the Yucatan Peninsula of Mexico.

"The trip by Oswald to Oriente Province was reportedly for the purpose of making contact with Raul Castro, the brother of Fidel Castro.

"This information came from Cubans in the Miami area."

I would also like to remind you that long ago you forwarded two of my requests to the CIA for processing. These requests involved the wiretaps at the Cuban and Russian embassies in Mexico city and CD 1359. I am still awaiting a response.
