Dear Mr. Roffman:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request of November 9, 1976, for copies of pictures and x-rays taken during the autopsy of President John F. Kennedy and related examinations, their chain of possession, and the various transfers of them between the government and the Kennedy family. Your request was received by the Division's Freedom of Information/Privacy Act Unit on November 12, 1976.

We have searched the index for the central Civil Rights Division's filing system and have found no records indexed on the matter.

We have consulted with the Freedom of Information Privacy Act Unit, Office of Management and Finance, and have been informed that your original request letter of September 9, 1976, was referred to the Criminal Division and to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for appropriate action. As soon as your request to these Divisions is processed, each will respond directly to you.
