telephonically contacted this office in regard to an article appearing in the March 6, 1964 edition of the Dallas Times Herald. The instant article by DARWIN
PAYNE concerned one JAMES RICHARD WORBELL who claims to have observed an unknown man run from the back door of the TSBD immediately after the Assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

ROMACK stated he works and worked for at the pertinent time the MKT Railroad on the loading docks immediately behind the TSBD. ROMACK stated on Nov. 22, 1963 he was eating lunch on the loading dock behind the TSBD when he heard three shots. Immediately afterwards he m saw a Dallas Policeman running along the east side of the TSBD north toward him. ROMACK allegedly told the officer he would watch the back of the TSBD and the officer went on back toward the front of the building.

shots he did not leave the area of the MKT loading dock and was able to observe all activity behind the TSBD. In doing so, ROMACK stated he definately never saw anyone leave by the back door of the TSBD as alleged by WORRELL in above mentioned newspaper story.

ROMACK stated he would be available for interview at his home or place of business.
