## Report of a 1961 Plot to Kill Kennedy SFChronicle

The newspaper L'Aurore published yesterday an account of a former French resident of Alger-ia who said that in 1981 he had been hired to kill President Kennedy, but that he had withdrawn from the assignment at the last moment.

The newspaper said Jose Luis Romero, who now lives at an undisclosed place in South America, had signed a contract with a French book publisher for the story of his life.

The article quoted Romero as saying that the attempt on Mr. Kennedy's life was to have been made during tha American president's visit to France to talk with General Charles de Ganile.

Romero said that in Algiers he had been offered \$460,000 through a man identified only as "Mike" who "visibly worked for certain secret services of the United States." He said that after he went to Parishe got wor-ried. He checked with the Secret Army Organization in Algiers, and got orders to pall out of the deal.
