You take 1270 from the Beltwat, 1495. How you get on the Beltway depends on where you start. I'll tell you how from downtown.

Take the "eorge "ashington "emorial Highway North, which is really Canal Road extended, to I495. Be certain not to take the exit to River Road and it puts you on the Beltway. But right after you go under River Road take one of the two left lanes. That gives you no choice - it puts you on I2/0.

Take Exit 7, which is marked "ood College and Ft. Detrick, and loop under the road you've just left, on Rosemont Ave., and in the direction of the forst. In about a city block, as short distance, so be alert, there is a small road that begins on the left, Shookstown Road. Take it to Old Receiver Road and turn right on Old Receiver. You'll be in the flat until you come to the village of Shookstown, about six-seten minutes from the beginning of that road. Then you start going up the mlountain.
