Thanks for your letter of the 2d and its enclosures.

While my age and impaired health make it impossible for me to become involved in what is not directly related to my work, and the kind of research you enclose is not (which does not mean that it is not of value to others), you are quite welcome to come any time you are near.

And see anything you want to see. But this means you have to be able to identify it, because I have preserved all the records received under FOIA exactly as I received them. This is essential to ultimate archival deposit.

We are about an hour from Washington. I'm gone until 10:30 a.m. every morning, therapy, but most days I'm home the rest of the day.

If and when you come, let me know to be certain it does not conflict with any medical or other need, and I'll then give you instructions.

It is an easy drive, with dual highway all the way except for less than the last ten minutes.
