REMARKS

I don't know if these two memos have any pertinent connection, but it is interesting that it both cases individuals connected with the bullfighting business in Mexico claim to have knowledge of the assassination.

In the one case, two school teachers said (through a third party) that they met a [redacted] by the name of [redacted] also known as [redacted] in Cuernavaca, Mexico in February 1967 and that he credited the New Orleans investigation and claimed to have "vast personal knowledge of events leading to the assassination."

Departmental files contain no record on [redacted] or [redacted]. Insofar as the conversation is concerned, this information is probably reliable. With the information provided, it looks like it might be possible to find him in Mexico, or at least perhaps

the original sources, the two school teachers,  
should be interviewed.

In the other case, a bankrobber who was convicted  
for 20 years in December 1966 in Los Angles is  
trying to wheel and deal his way out of jail on  
the grounds that he has information concerning the  
assassination, knew of the meeting where the  
assassination was planned, has documentary proof,  
and knows of two witnesses who have fled the  
country. (It is noted that [REDACTED] above, drives  
a car with New York license plates.) He also  
says that the information from New Orleans  
"adds perfectly" with what he has. *TC*

This individual, [REDACTED] has lived  
in various cities in Mexico and has fought in the  
bull ring as a bullfighter. *TC*

He refuses to furnish any information unless released  
from jail and transported to Mexico. He threatens  
to write the President and Attorney General.

Two of the three psychiatrists who have seen him  
in this regard feel that his information is  
probably fictitious. Another isn't too sure.

*TC* If these two memos do indicate a possible connection  
between [REDACTED] information in view of  
the bullfighting aspect, it might be easier to  
*TC* try to locate [REDACTED] in Mexico or at least check  
with the two school teachers who talked to him.  
*TC* [REDACTED] won't be going anywhere for quite a while.
