

## 5 Subpoenaed To Testify in Rosselli Killing

MIAMI (AP) — Five reputed Mafia members and associates, including Meyer Lansky and Anthony Giacalone, have been subpoenaed to answer questions this week about the murder of one-time Mafia member John Rosselli.

Rosselli's body was found stuffed in a chain-wrapped oil drum in Biscayne Bay near downtown Miami last August.

He had testified before several grand juries and committees, including the Senate Intelligence Committee. He told the Senate panel about his role in a CIA plan to use Mafia figures to assassinate Cuban Prime Minister Fidel Castro. The plot was never carried out.

Federal officials have called Lansky, 75, the financial wizard of the underworld. He now lives in Miami Beach.

Giacalone has been identified in Senate hearings as a member of the Mafia in Detroit and according to investigators was questioned about the disappearance of Jimmy Hoffa.

Also subpoenaed by the Dade County state attorney's office were Charles (The Blade) Tourine, who has a long criminal record.
