MIAMI, Aug. 8 (AP)-The body of John Roselli, a key figure with San Giancana, the slain Chicago mobster, in a Central Intelligence Agency plan to assassinate Premier Fidel Castro of Cuba, has been found in a chain-wrapped 55gallon drum floating in Biscayne Bay.

Mr. Roselli, 70 years old, was found yesterday by two fishermen. He had been missing since he left his sister's home on July 28 to play golf.
