Baker Asks Data on Roselli Death

Sen. Howard Baker, R-Tenn., says he will ask the FBI and the CIA to provide any information they have on the murder of John Roselli, an underworld strongarm man and gambler who testified he made several CIA-sanctioned attempts to assassinate Fidel Castro.

Baker, a member of the new Senate Intelligence Committee, said yesterday that he would talk with the committee's chairman, Sen. Daniel Inouye, about whether the panel should investigate links between the slaying of Roselli and that of Sam Giancana, who was murdered in his Chicago home in June 1975. "Both agreed to testify on the same subject," Baker said. "Both were involved in the same assassination operation."
