ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, NOVEMBER 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS.

[REDACTED] REPORTED THAT EARL GOLZ, REPORTER, DALLAS MORNING NEWS, DALLAS, TEXAS (A DAILY NEWSPAPER), CAME INTO POSSESSION OF DOCUMENTS THREE YEARS AGO FROM PAUL ROTHERMEL, FORMER SPECIAL AGENT, FBI, AND FORMER CHIEF OF SECURITY, FOR HUNT OIL COMPANY, DALLAS, TEXAS. GOLZ TOLD [REDACTED] HE HAS A DOCUMENT DATED NOVEMBER 4, 1963, FROM ROTHERMEL TO H. L. HUNT (NOW DECEASED) WHICH STATES ROTHERMEL WAS TOLD BY A RELIABLE SOURCE THAT THERE WOULD BE VIOLENCE ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE TO BE TAKEN BY THE PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY. THE COMMUNICATION FURTHER STATES ROTHERMEL REPORTED THIS INFORMATION TO DALLAS POLICE DEPT., AND THE FBI.

[REDACTED] REPORTED GOLZ HAS, OVER THE YEARS, WRITTEN STORIES OF POSSIBLE CONSPIRATORIAL PLOT TO ASSASSINATE THE PRESIDENT. THAT GOLZ WILL, IF THE STORY IS WRITTEN, TRY TO TIE IN H. L. HUNT, NOW DECEASED, INTO GATHERING INFORMATION ABOUT THE THEN UPCOMING

VISIT OF THE PRESIDENT. [REDACTED] HAD NO INFORMATION WHEN ROTHERMEL SUPPOSEDLY REPORTED THIS INFORMATION TO THE DALLAS POLICE DEPT. OR FBI, NOR INFORMATION AS TO THE IDENTITY OF ROTHERMEL'S RELIABLE SOURCE.

GOLZ IS OF THE OPINION, ALTHOUGH NEVER PROVEN, THAT H. L. HUNT MADE CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE JOHN BIRCH SOCIETY IN CALIFORNIA, WHO IN TURN WERE ALLEGEDLY FINANCING TRAINED ASSASSINS, INCLUDING AN INDIVIDUAL BY THE NAME OF EUGENE BRADY (POSSIBLY BRADLEY), <sup>CALIF</sup> WHO IS ALLEGED TO HAVE VISITED MR. HUNT A FEW DAYS BEFORE THE ASSASSINATION. Texas

[REDACTED] SAID HE WOULD ATTEMPT TO ASCERTAIN IF GOLZ WRITES THE STORY INCLUDING THE ABOVE INFORMATION AND [REDACTED] SPECULATED THAT IF THE STORY IS WRITTEN IT WILL POSSIBLY APPEAR IN THE DALLAS MORNING NEWS DURING THE PERIOD OCTOBER 6-13, 1975.

REVIEW OF DALLAS INDICES AND ALL INDICATED REFERENCES FAILS TO DISCLOSE ANY RECORD OF ROTHERMEL HAVING FURNISHED INFORMATION TO THE EFFECT THERE WOULD BE VIOLENCE ALONG THE KENNEDY PARADE ROUTE. NOR HAS ANY INFORMATION BEEN LOCATED IN DALLAS FILES TO SUBSTANTIATE ANY OF THE OTHER ABOVE INFORMATION.
