Dear Paul,

Enclosed are the only references to you I've seen since the last copies I sent you. These are from FBIHQ assassination file records.

I suggest that one of them indicates someone in FBIHQ does not love you any more because it suggests that you were a DL informer in 1963. If so under the law they are entitled to withhold this. The manner of withholding is suggestive rather than otherwise. And I do not believe those people do not know their business. Usual practise is to abuse the exemptions and to withholding improperly, withhold what they should not.

Earl has never mentioned this to me.

I have no special interest in the source of the report to Earl, clearly twisted, but if it suggests anything of interest to you I'd be interested.

At the time of these records the FBI, HQ and DL, was more than usually uptight over a flap, that Oswald had left that note for Hosty.

The story was leaked to the Times-Herald as I recall in July. It checked with the FBI promptly and ran its story 8/31/75.

There then was what might be called an internal investigation, really a con job. A House Judiciary committee also held hearings.

I'd hoped to be able to return to Dallas before now but it has not been possible.
