Shaneyfelt, who I will be desposing about the time you receive this if all stays on schedule, had a remarkable skill in making clear pictures unclear. I do not believe it will impair the functioning of the courts if I provide clear pix. The film of Tom ~~Bick~~ Dillard and Jim Underwood provide this possibility, if I can obtain prints from them, for court, not personal uses.

In this connection I would also like to be able to locate and speak to Buddy Walthers' widow, who may be remarried by now, and to Jim Kerr, who was with me much of an informative day I spent largely with the late Alan Sweatt. Jim may be able to recall the deputy who was with us. I'd like to be able to talk to him, too.

Donnie tells me that Jim's sight has failed much.

All of this relates to the so-called "missed" shot the spray of concrete from which inflicted a minor wound on Jim Tague. Donnie says a black woman whose name he does not recall also was wounded. This is not in any Commission records of which I know.

If it is possible for you to have Jim's and Carolyn Walther's phone numbers for me and anything else relevant in this matter I'd appreciate it much.

Maybe, if I am able to go there, we could spend a few pleasant moments together?
Hope so.
