From today's TV you are just having some of our kind of weather. Must be hard on those not used to it. We've had regular wind-chill days of 50 below. That is colder than usual here. Snow in Mobile must have struck some there as Judgement Day.

If you hear from the new House committee I encourage care and not the imparting of initial trust. I know of nothing good it has done and of much not good. After my initial experiences I've been staying away from them.
