Sorry to have been silent so long. I've been more busy than ever, between New Orleans, where I was for a week, and here working on what is by far the most significant information we have ever had. The time pressure is great because there is no help on the work I'm doing. My wife has returned to work so that the food we eat will not increase our indebtedness by that much daily.

Ramsey Clark blew his cool in his last minutes. Those documents he filed in court in Washington contain his ruin and the total destruction of the Warren Report and those behind it if we can get the audience for what I have discovered it in. I've a 30,000-word addition to my book on the autopsy drafted on that material. I've given the lawyer who is handling it all he needs and he is to file the brief today. The Washington press being what it is, I am not as hopeful as I would like to be. However, if you know anyone who is interested in Clark, I have what I think can be said about few public officials in our history, it is that very awful. And it is irrefutable.

In haste, I tell you this: he has given me the proof of the falsity of the autopsy, which means of the entire assassination story, and I have woven it together with the record of the Commission to prove that there was wilful sabotage. I think that only federal unwillingness will prevent criminal prosecutions. If and when they happen ---
