Cited for Contempt

DALLAS, Tex., Dec. 14 (AP) — A private detective convicted of wire tapping home telephones of former top aides of Dallas millionaire H. L. Hunt has been cited for contempt of court for refusing to testify at a federal grand jury investigation of the case.

U. S. District Court Judge Robert M. Hill gave John Joseph Kelly, 27, of Houston, until Jan. 11 to decide whether he will testify or face an 18-month jail sentence for contempt.
