I have received much excellent information from Gary Schoener. He is quite a research man, and without his kindly furnishing it to me, I would have been ignorant of many important documents.

This past weekend, I had what looked like a small burglary in my office. I had kept one of my file cabinets locked with both the file cabinet lock and an iron bar.
