Home from hospital yesterday, loaded with clots, anti-coagulation and frost bitten over being flat on back with the most definite work of all, being printed. It is this definite: there is no reasonable objection to it, it addresses all the essential terminological ...

As long as I'm on back, I feel o.k. The book is Post Mortem if you know any who will want copies I will now be able to seek someone to distribute. It is a very large book - 660 pp. We have ordered a special envelope for it. It will be \$10.75 by insured mail. Almost 200 pp. facsimiles including a few selections of what the Commission never had. What I got from 3 lawsuits and as an alternative to filing them. It has come to the point where the Bureau & I have told the federal courts that I know more about the subject than anyone in the FBI. Their "answer" to my charging & proving perjury. It is a hot book & with my back & attention, should break the case open (not solve it).
