Don't know which is worse, my writing or typing. I have an aching leg I have to keep propped up. It held off long enough for me to get my next book in manufacture. Don't know when it will be done & out but it is definite. Getting it done kept me going at a stiff pace & from doing almost anything else. Thus my failure to thank you for the clippings on the trial. I do not assume that these clippings tell the whole story. I hope the trial does not forecast Perry Foreman's future.

There are what appear to me some unusual aspects to the leak of the story that Oswald left a threatening letter at the Dallas FBI office & that it was destroyed. Reporters working on the story tell me the FBI says there was a chain from Hosty to Shanklin to Moore to Hoover - who exploded and ordered the destruction. If I have a few questions about this, it is the FBI's story.

I also understand that Bill Alexander did the leaking. One version has it to do with Tom Johnson. I don't know.

2) What I do to now is that there are some remarkable coincidences in the timing of the leak alone. One of these is that after almost 12 yrs. it comes when Shunklin returns. There are going to be more news stories on LHO's possible comments because people from CIA & FBI are talking to reporters. All that has come back to me is self serving.
