I recently received "Post Mortem" from you, and as usual, it is an excellent book. I read all I can on the assassination and I consider you by far the expert on the subject. I realize you receive letters from "buffs" all the time and I know you've probably tired of them. However, I honestly hope you can give me an answer to my question, as I have not seen a full explanation on it anywhere.
