Re FD-302 of BRYAN POWELL, owner, Graphic Studios, 1310 Main Street, by writer of 12/6/63.

At the time of the interview POWELL made available a sheet of paper containing a list of names, addresses, and/or phone calls, which RUBY had inadvertently delivered to POWELL's print shop in early November, 1963, in connection with some printing he desired. It is noted that a number of these items also appear in serial 644 of this case, pages 724 through 773, which contain various listings of names, addresses and/or phone numbers secured from RUBY at the time of his arrest.

Set forth below are the items as secured from POWELL, with comments as to their relationship with material in serial 644 and in investigation:
