Diagnostic Report on Ruby Will Be Released Today

DALLAS, Dec. 14 (AP) — Diagnostic studies are near an end for cancer-stricken Jack Ruby, doctors announced tonight. Earlier today, one of his doctors expressed further doubt that Ruby can survive.

The latest Parkland Hospital report said Ruby's condition was unchanged, and that his

diagnosis should be complete by noon tomorrow.

Ruby once escaped the electric chair for killing Lee Harvey Oswald, President Kennedy's assassin. He was taken from his Dallas County jail cell last Friday to Parkland, where doctors found that he had cancer.

Doctors have not announced discovery of the primary cancer source, but the prediction of the completion of diagnosis indicated a definite statement was forthcoming of his hopes for life, or for facing a new trial.
