## Ruby Guard Says He Was Shot At

A former Dallas County sheriff's deputy who is writing a book on his conversations with Jack Ruby "which will shed light on many things people are talking about" said he was shot at near League City while driving his car Thursday.

Norman Hooten, now a Galveston County game warden who was a deputy while Jack Ruby was in Parkland Memorial Hospital with terminal cancer, said he was shot at 30 miles southeast of Houston, a Galveston County sheriff's deputy told Associated Press.

Hooten told a newspaper Wednesday that New Orleans Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison is "on the right track" in his assassination plot probe.
