BILL ALEXANDER, Assistant District Attorney, Dallas County, Dallas, Texas, telephonically contacted the Dallas Office at approximately 10:10 A.M. this date and advised that he desired certain information from the FBI in connection with a sanity hearing which will be afforded JACK RUBY sometime in the future.

ALEXANDER stated that Agents sat in on a hearing held by the Warren Commission, at which time RUBY was afforded a polygraph examination. He stated that an Agent sat in on the Warren Commission Hearing and took shorthand notes of the entire proceedings. He assumes these notes were transcribed. ALEXANDER desires to know the name of the Agent taking the shorthand notes, as well as his availability.

ALEXANDER stated that he recalled that during the Warren Commission Hearing that RUBY declined to answer certain questions, specifically with respect to Jewish persecution. The prosecution desires to review this area concerning Jewish persecution completely.

ALEXANDER stated that the contents of the transcribed notes will not be used except for the sanity hearing and possibly a subsequent jury trial. He would like to know when he can possibly get the material, inasmuch as the prosecution's psychiatrist would like to go over the material in its entirety.

ALEXANDER was advised he would receive a return call sometime this date. Further, he was informed that it may be necessary that we get in touch with our Washington Headquarters as to what action may be taken.
