"....Jim Zimmerman, a thirty-one-year-old former Office of Strategic Investigation agent and assistant district attorney for two and a half years..." The index reveals no other reference to an Office of Strategic Investigation. This office is not in any way identified, but from its name it would not seem to be a Texas state organization. If Fderal, I recall none of that name. If it is intended as a reference to the OSS, then Zimmerman was at most 14 yea4s old when he was an intelligence agent for it, for it was then out of businessm that is, at the time of the trial, and had been for 17 years.
