Belli Plans Ruby Appeal

SAN FRANCISCO (P) — Attorney Melvin Belli said Sunday night he has agreed to file an appeal brief for Jack Ruby, his former client sentenced to death for the murder of Lee Harvey Oswald, called the killer of President Kennedy in the Warren Commission report issued Sunday.

Belli said Ruby asked him to do so and that he agreed. Ruby's family dismissed Belli from the case last March shortly after Ruby received the death sentence.

Ruby, calling from the Dallas jail, reached Belli at a lawyers' meeting in Santa Monica, Caif., Sunday.
