Pistol to Archives?

DETROIT — Jack Ruby's heirs said they have offered to give the National Archives in Washington the pistol with which Ruby kined presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald.

The attorney for the estate, Alan Adelson, said, however, that the gun's ultimate disposition would be up to the Dallas, Texas, courts.

Adelson discussed the gun and other effects in disclosing an agreement reached in Dallas last Friday over Ruby's will. Under the agreement, a 1950 handwritten will rather than two death-bed wills was accepted by all interested parties as the true document
