On 11/27/63, a female individual, who refused to identify herself, telephonically advised SA CARL E. UNDERHILL that she had a daughter who is known as CAROL ANNIE DEEVER, who, at the present time, is about 21 years old, but with whom the caller has had no contact for over a year. The caller said she had heard that DEEVER had gone to Mississippi with a hair dresser.

The caller advised that DEEVER had at one time worked at the Carousel Club and later had worked at the Casino Club and that she had been introduced into this type of life by a Dallas police officer by the name of BOB STAFFORD. She said STAFFORD had started reading articles about her daughter when the daughter was about 17 years old. She said she had complained at that time to the Dallas PD and STAFFORD had been transferred to another division but he had been discharged.

The caller said she did not know if this was of any significance, but she wished to report this to the Dallas PD Office.

On 12/4/63 Sgt. R. H. STRAMER, sergeant in charge of the Dallas PD Office, advised the caller by his department under the name BOB STAFFORD. He stated that he had a BILL H. STAFFORD who presently works on the 4:00 AM to Midnight shift in the Radio Patrol Division, and he would make arrangements for interview of BILL H. STAFFORD on that date.
