SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63,
DALLAS, TEXAS

On 11/28/63, Mr. WILLIAM BOYKIN, Investigator, Department of Public Safety, Dallas, Texas, telephone BR 9-7770, called and advised that State Attorney General WAGGONER CARR had contacted the Department of Public Safety in Austin advising that he had received a letter from an individual which stated that the name JACK RUBENSTEIN had appeared in the House Committee on Un-American Activities in 1940. BOYKIN stated that this information was recorded in Part I, Page 919, HCUA Records, and Volume I, 592, 593, and 631 of the same records. BOYKIN stated that this had something to do with JACK RUBENSTEIN's being connected with the Young Communists League. He stated that WAGGONER CARR wanted to find out if the JACK RUBENSTEIN set out in the HCUA records was identical with JACK RUBY, aka Jack Rubenstein, who was the slayer of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

BOYKIN stated that CARR also wanted determined how LEE HARVEY OSWALD came back to the United States after visiting in Mexico in September, 1963.

After consultation with Inspector MALLEY and SAC SHANKLIN, Mr. BOYKIN was recontacted and advised that this investigation was being conducted at the specific request of the President of the United States. It was also stated that the newspapers had quoted President JOHNSON as saying he was going to make a full public disclosure of the facts in this matter. It was pointed out that this office could not release any information concerning this or other matters until such time as ordered by the President or the Bureau.

It was determined that the facts surrounding OSWALD's trip to Mexico had been covered and that leads had been set out to determine whether JACK RUBENSTEIN cited in the HCUA records was identical with JACK RUBY. 89-43-107

SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF
PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

At 3:08 p.m., 11/24/63, SA ALBERT SAYERS received a telephone call from a man who said he would rather not identify himself. He advised that JACK RUBY is connected with the Chicago underworld. He would not furnish any specific names in Chicago. He said he was watching TV today while they were transferring LEE HARVEY OSWALD from the Dallas PD to the Dallas County Jail and at the time he saw OSWALD he also saw JACK RUBY on the TV screen. He saw OSWALD look at RUBY and OSWALD recognized RUBY. This was shortly before OSWALD was shot. He added that LEE OSWALD has been at JACK RUBY's place a number of times.

This man also said that they had better watch out for BOBBY KENNEDY because "they" are after him, too.

SA SAYERS was in the process of trying to obtain specific information from the anonymous caller when the telephone connection was cut off.
